# QUICK SETUP GUIDE

## INITIAL SETUP

### 1. Unbox Carefully

Remove the protective plastic, avoiding any damage to the chassis.

### 2. Position the Device

Place on a stable surface with at least 10 cm clearance on all sides for proper airflow.

### 3. Connect to the Internet

- Plug an Ethernet cable from your modem or router into “network” input on the back of the Eidos Streamer.
- A Gigabit LAN connection (1000BASE-T) is recommended for best performance.

### 4. Connect Your Goldmund Active Speaker

- Ensure the Eidos Streamer is in standby mode.
- Next, connect to the Eidos Streamer either the wireless USB dongle supplied with your active speaker or use S/PDIF cables.

### 5. Power On

- Verify the correct voltage on the back panel before connecting the power cable.
- The Eidos Streamer will begin its test sequence (indicated by flashing orange LED).
- When the orange LED stops blinking and emits a dim glow, the Eidos Streamer has entered low-power mode and is ready for startup.

### 6. Power Off

- To turn off the unit, unplug the power cord.
- Before reconnecting and using the device again, allow the internal capacitor to fully discharge. The discharge process is indicated by the front LED flashing, which will last approximately 5–10 minutes after unplugging the device.

## FIRST STARTUP

### 1. Start the Device

While in low-power mode, briefly press the button located beneath the Eidos Streamer, centered on the front panel. The LED will transition from dim to bright, indicating the startup sequence has begun.

### 2. Wait for Initialization

Allow 3-4 minutes for the Eidos Streamer to complete its boot-up process.

### 3. Connect to the Network

- Ensure your phone, tablet, or computer is connected to the same network as the Eidos Streamer.

### 4. Start Your Musical Journey

- Download the *Roon Remote* app, which will automatically detect your Eidos Streamer.
- The app will display the device’s serial number. Select it and log in with your Roon credentials.

*Note: A valid Roon subscription is required to play music.*

### 5. Access the Control Panel

- For more information, visit the support section by entering your device’s serial number followed by “.local” in your web browser.
